

Rossini's L'Italiana in Algeri is one of the funniest and best loved operas composed by Rossini, at 21 yrs old. The work was first performed at the Teatro San Benedetto, Venice on May 22, 1813. The opera is notable for Rossini's mixing opera seria style with opera buffa. The overture widely recorded, known for its distinct opening of low, quiet pizzicato basses, leading to a sudden loud burst from the full Orchestra
