The Nominating committee presented a Slate of officers at the Nov.3rd General membership meeting, consisting of President: Ronald DeBacco. 1st VP: Ben Petrone. 2nd VP: Joe Carbone, Treasurer: Ralph Maccarone, Recording Sec: Kate Antico, Corresponding Sec: Charles Mossorofo, (nominated from the floor) Past President: Bruce Bastian. According to the By Laws of 1/6/2011, Article XII Sec.1, Item G states: The election will be held at the December General Meeting & shall be held by secret ballot, in the Columbus room.

Roberts Rules state: if the bylaws require the election of officers to be by ballot & there is only one nominee for an office, the ballot must nevertheless be taken for that office, unless the bylaws provide for an exception in such a case. Our bylaws do not provide an exception, therefore there will be a secret ballot election on December 1st.
